A Vic Bergeron (aka Trader Vic) creation from 1944, utilising the St Lucian Chairman's Reserve Original and Spiced.

DAIQUIRI £8

In honour of Shervene Shahbazkhani, Global Brand Ambassador for Bacardi, who serves the most perfect of Daiquiri that creator Jennings Cox showcased himself back in 1896.

BACARDÍ CARTA BLANCA / LIME / SUGAR

CUBAN MOJITO £8

Another tip-of-the-hat to Meimi Sanchez, Global Brand Ambassador of Havana Club, who inspires all to go 'Cuban' when having your Mojito, replacing soda with sparkling water for a fresher experience.

HAVANA CLUB AÑEJO 3 AÑOS / SUGAR / LIME / MINT / SPARKLING WATER

PIÑA COLADA £8

Created in Barrachina within San Juan, Puerto Rico by Ramón Portas Mingot back in 1963. No singing when you order this . .

DON Q GOLD / KOKO KANU / PINEAPPLE / COCONUT

Try our gin version, replacing Don Q Gold with Hoxton's coconut and grapefruit.

DARK N' STORMY £7

A trademarked classic from the Gosling Brothers in Bermuda since the 1970's.

GOSLING'S BLACK SEAL / DOUBLE DUTCH GINGER BEER / LIME

PLANTER'S PUNCH £8

Writer Patrick Chamboiseau once wrote "a rum punch takes a good six hours to penetrate the soul. Six hours between the midday punch that wards off the sun's madness and the push before your evening soup, the commander of your dreams".

APPLE SHACK £7

A blend of Caribbean rum and spice propped up with fresh flavours of apple and ginger.

REDLEG SPICED / APPLE / DOUBLE DUTCH GINGER BEER / CINNAMON / LIME

EVENING STYLES

EL PRESIDENTE £8

From the golden age of Cuban Club de Cantineros, this stirred down serve originates from Havana and most likely named after Cuban President Gerado Machado.

DOORLY'S 3 YEAR / BLANC VERMOUTH / DRY CURUÇAO

PAINKILLER £8

Known as the "Official Cocktail of the British Virgin Islands", served within a British Navy style mug.

PUSSER'S GUNPOWDER / PINEAPPLE / ORANGE / COCONUT

CAUSE FOR CONCERN £8

Marigot Bay owner's favourite rum cocktail created by Ehren Khoo-Steel of Brass Monkey in Nottingham. If you like your Negroni, this St Lucian spiced rum variation will be top-of-your-list to experience.

CHAIRMAN'S RESERVE SPICED / JOHN D.TAYLOR'S VELVET FALERNUM / CAMPARI

TI' PUNCH £8

Heading over from the French islands of the West Indies using local Rhum Agricole, this translates to 'little punch'. Like an Espresso, it's short with a 50% abv kick.

RHUM ST BARTH BLANC / SUGAR / LIME

HURRICANE £8

Pat O'Brien's Irish bar in New Orleans takes credit for this long, strong, yet refreshing serve.

SMITH AND CROSS / PASSIONFRUIT / LEMON

TREACLE £8

Created by British bartending legend Dick Bradsell, this is a short twist on the Old Fashioned.

MATUSALEM AÑEJO / APPLE / SUGAR / ANGOSTURA BITTERS

THE GOVENER £8

Our special 'other world' rum cocktail, i.e. not a serve to be found in the Caribbean, but Mauritius in the Indian Ocean.

PENNY BLUE VSOP / BLANC VERMOUTH / COINTREAU / MARASCHINO

ZOMBIE £10

First appeared in late 1934, invented by Donn Beach of Hollywood's Don the Beachcomber restaurant.

MARGARITA £8

Spanish for 'daisy', the first mention of the name Margarita was within Esquire's December 1953 issue, but it's commonly seen as 19th July 1939's Albuquerque Journal's naming of the recipe 'The Daisy' as the kick-start of this tequila classic.

CASCO VIEJO REPOSADO / LIME / COINTREAU / AGAVE

THE SATURN £8

Created by Stephen Halpin of Dallas, Texas, he says "This light & refreshing, citrusy brunch cocktail has big passionfruit and lemon flavors, not big enough for rings though."

PATRÓN SILVER / JOHN D.TAYLOR'S VELVET FALERNUM / ORGEAT / PASSIONFRUIT / LEMON

LYNCHBURG LEMONADE £7

A refreshing long serve for the warm evenings of Lynchburg as you dream of your trip to the beach.

RED STRIPE – 4.7% abv £4.20
